

Parental Access to Instructional Material

6500.

In accordance with federal law established by the Meriden Board of Education (the "Board") and in compliance with the 2026-2027 school year, and each school year thereafter, the Board shall post the "Instructional Material" means any instructional content that is provided to students regardless of whether it is used for academic assessment purposes or for any other purpose, and the Board shall permit parents or guardians to inspect all instructional material used in the district's public schools and to request a copy of such material.
