 - __ c. Homeowner's insurance policy (policy must be current and in effect)
 - __ d. Rental agreement showing student(s) name

AND

- Copy of one of the following:
 - __ a. Current utility bill or home telephone bill
 - __ b. Automobile insurance
 - __ c. Bank or credit card statement
 - __ d. Current paycheck stub with address of residence

- __ 2. If the student and the parent/guardian are living in a dwelling that is rented or owned and occupied by another person, that person who owns or rents the dwelling must bring documentation mentioned in number 1, present photo identification, and sign a Certification of Residence form.

- __ 3. If the student claims residence in Meriden but is not residing with his or her parent(s), and his or her parents are either residing or not residing in Meriden, the person with whom the student resides in Meriden must bring documentation mentioned in number 1 above, present photo identification, and complete a Residency Affidavit.
